Graduate Applicant Checklist	
GRE	GRE is not required
TOEL or IELTS	International applicants only
Transcripts	Refer to the Graduate Division Requirement https://graduate.ucr.edu/admission-requirements#academic-degrees-and-records
Letters of Recommendation	Three letters of recommendation are required. At least two of these letters should be requested from academic references (such as research supervisors and course instructors) who can comment on your academic achievement, quality of research experience, motivation for PhD study, work ethic, and resilience.
Statement of Purpose (2-page maximum)	Please describe your motivation to apply for the CEE PhD program at UCR, your research interests, and any faculty member's research that is of specific interest to you. You should also describe any of your prior research experiences to demonstrate your research readiness and commitment to scholarly work.
Personal History Statement (2-page maximum)	We encourage you to share how your personal background informs your decision to pursue a PhD degree. Please include any educational, familial, cultural, economic or social experiences, challenges, or opportunities relevant to your academic journey; how you might contribute to social or cultural diversity within your chosen field.
Resume or CV (2-page maximum)	A bulleted list of your qualifications, honors, and academic achievements including publications.
Application Fee	Fee waivers are available to qualified domestic applicants only.
